

1. Kf2 Rg4 The King hides behind the pawn and gets time for some important trades.
2. Nxc4 bxc4
3. Bxf3 Nxf3
4. Qxf3 Qc2+
5. Qe2 Qf5+
6. Kg1 h5
7. Rf1 Qg6
8. Kh1 h4
9. Bxc7 h3
10. Qf3 Qd3
11. Be5 Rg2
12. Bc3 Black resigns.

1. Nxf3 Qh3+ Looks good at first, but it's a disaster for White.
2. Kxh3 Bf1#

1. Nxf3 Qh3+
2. Kf2 Qf1+
3. Ke3 b4 White is lost.
